Company was organized at Livingston, Polk County, Texas, in July, 1861, and was mustered into the Confederate service "for the war," Sept. 9, 1861 at Camp Van Dorn, Tex. Company included men from Liberty, Livingston, and Trinity Counties, as well as Polk County.
